



Introduction

Kijang Economics Competition (KEC) is a national economics competition for primary, secondary and pre-university students which aims to challenge students' economics knowledge through economics, entrepreneurship, financial literacy and business. The first competition will take place in April 2019.

KEC intends to spark a competitive nature among students as provide them with the opportunity to polish and develop in economic and financial literacy. KEC questions has a unique way of highlighting economic and financial concepts by relating it to the local and global economies over time.

KEC tasks consist of multiple choice questions (tests), requiring an application of economic and financial knowledge to find solutions on capital resources, use of financial instruments and financial market analysis. The questions in KEC are aligned with the Malaysian curriculum standards and Elemen Merentas Kurikulum (EMK) in KSSR and KSSM. KEC is endorsed by the Ministry of Education Malaysia, which enables all participants to obtain co-curriculum marks.

About Kijang Economics Competitions

KEC has three categories which is sorted by age groups; namely as Primary, Lower Secondary, and Upper Secondary.

All questions are designed and specifically trained for economics studies by the expatriates in economics.

Economics has a diverse range of field. Among them are:




Objectives

Competition Format



The competition will be administered at each participating school under invigilation from the respective school teacher(s).



There are 30 objective questions for each category to be answered in 1 hour.



Students are allowed to bring stationary and unprogrammed calculator only.



Students are prohibited to discuss with anyone while taking the exam.



MINIMUM participants for each registered school is 5 students.

Who should participate?

Kijang is suitable for all primary school, secondary school and pre-university students within the age group of 7 to 18 years old.



Award & Certificate

 Every participant will receive a certificate of participation jointly issued by the Director of Kijang Secretariat and Ministry of Education Malaysia.



Certificates and medals will be couriered to the schools.

Competition Procedure



Registration should be carried out by the appointed teacher or person-in-charge only.



On the competition day, the schools will conduct the competition at their own venues.



The teacher / person-in-charge has to open the packages and check if it is the right package, to avoid any inconvenience on the competition day.



Schools will enforce the regulations of the competition, especially in making sure that the questions are not leaked before the competition day, and that the questions are not published online until one month after the competition day.



Schools will then send back the answer sheets to the Kijang Economics Malaysia Secretariat.




If there are any mistakes in the package, do contact us immediately.

How to Register



1. Log on into www.kijang.my and go to Registration section to complete the registration.



2. Click Register and fill in FULL SCHOOL NAME for example "SEKOLAH MENENGAH KEBANGSAAN SERI TUALANG" and complete the teacher-in-charge information.

3. The system will send a temporary password to your email and log on into the website using your email and the temporary password.



4. Please change your new password.



5. Next, click List of Competition and click Kijang Economics Challenge.



6. Add your students information and then click proceed to payment.



7. Complete the payment



8. Attach the payment slip to the system.



9. Registration is complete.
